



## Care & Maintenance of your Quartz or Granite Counters

Quartz countertops, such as Silestone, CaesarStone, Zodiaq, and Cambria, as well as natural Granite counters, require very little maintenance and are easy to care for.

For daily maintenance, simply wipe with warm water and soap, using a damp cloth or paper towel. You can also use mild household cleaners like Formula 409, Fantastik, Lysol, or Windex.

Wipe up spills immediately to avoid staining. For stubborn or dried spills, scrape off excess material with a plastic putty knife, then use a non-abrasive cleaning pad such as a white 3M Scotch-Brite scrub pad along with a mild household cleaner to remove any remaining spill.

Avoid using cleaners that contain bleach and harsh chemicals like oven cleaners which can harm quartz and granite surfaces.

Quartz countertops will not need to be sealed.

Granite should be sealed every 1 to 2 years using a sealer such as Stone Spray-N-Seal from Stone Care Int'l. Follow directions on the product.

Using a cutting board will avoid dulling your knives. It is also recommended you use heat pads or trivets with hot pots to help maintain the beauty of your countertop.
