## Care & Maintenance

*With a little care you can keep your cabinetry looking beautiful for years*

### **Cleaning:**

- Clean cabinets with a product like Murphy's Oil Soap and dry immediately. Clean up spills and water marks as they occur keeping the surface dry. Excess moisture will damage any finish over time. Draping damp or wet items over cabinets will damage the finish.
- If a stronger cleaner is needed, test on an inconspicuous area before using on the rest of your cabinets.
- Use a polish designed for kitchen cabinets such as lemon oil. Apply to a soft cloth and then onto the clean cabinets. It will add a protective layer as well as a luster to your cabinets.

### **Caution:**

- Using harsh chemicals, cleaners or abrasive pads will scratch and penetrate the surface allowing moisture to enter and cause deterioration of the finish.
- Products containing wax or silicone are not recommended and will build-up and attract dirt and other pollutants, and may cause deterioration of the finish.
- Extremes in room humidity and temperature should be avoided.. Low humidity (25% or less) or high humidity (55% or more) will cause expansion or contraction resulting in cracks, splits, joint separation etc.
