Granite and Quartz countertops require very little maintenance and are easy to care for.

- Quartz countertops will not need sealing.
- Granite is sealed if water stops beading up.

AKEMI is the penetrating sealer we use. Follow directions.



Helpful Tips:

- Clean with warm water and soap.
- Clean up spills to avoid staining.
- Cutting on stone counters will dull your knives and cutting boards are suggested.
- Trivets are recommended for hot pots.
- For tough spots, use a razor blade and scrape away residue prior to cleaning.
- For deeper cleaning (always rinse and wipe dry after use)
 - Mild household detergent: 409, Fantastic, or equivalent
 - Denatured Alcohol
 - 50/50 combination vinegar and water
